

National policy

There are two sides to Dutch government policy regarding digital preservation

Decentralised approach:

- Strengthening local activities and innovation
- Promoting creation of institutional ICT policies
- Investing in staff training
- Funding on national, provincial and local level


Strengthening the national infrastructure in EU-context:

- "Digital Collection Netherlands"
- Infrastructure for preservation and access
- Legal framework / copyright
- Quality assurance based on self regulation




Facts & Figures (1)

Institution collects born digital heritage (n = 98)






Facts & Figures (2)

(European average: 30%)



Owns facilities for reliable storage of digital information (n = 131)



Netherlands Coalition for Digital Preservation


Established in 2008

- The Netherlands Cultural Heritage Coalition for Digital Preservation (CCDD)


Mission To establish an infrastructure for long-term access to all public-sector digital objects in the Netherlands within five years





Factor C, stakeholder analysis, brief explanation

- "Factor C" is developed by and for Dutch Government communication policy development.
 See <u>website</u> (Dutch only, sorry)
- this diagram (one of the first steps of the method) is made for NCDD, NOT for one partner or institution
- 4 quadrants (i.e. Influencers, Deciders, Suppliers / Executioners, and Users / Consumers)
- 4 levels of involvement (i.e. Knowing, Thinking, Operations, and Deciding)
- all stakeholders are plotted on the diagram, representing their present position
- arrows indicate to what segment you ideally would want to move the stakeholder
- next steps:
 - define principal stakeholders
 - develop core message per stakeholder
 - develop agenda (calendar)
 - start to communicate
- the principal funder of NCDD and most cultural heritage institutions and Programs is the Dutch ministry of Education, Culture and Science (OCW). So that's why OCW and several of its Directories General appear in the diagram....





2010: NCDD strategic agenda

- Key to long-term access = cooperation and collaboration
- A distributed national network for long-term access
- By pooling limited resources more organisations can benefit
- Dual-axis approach: both *within* domains and *between* domains


